

# MUTTS & BUTTS

## Terms & Conditions 2020

- You must be the registered owner or have permission as a handler, carer, walker or trainer to bring any dog to fun agility.
- Only vaccinated dogs will be allowed to attend fun agility. All vaccinations must be up to date and a vaccination record/certificate must be produced on or before first visit.
- All dogs must be wormed and have had flea treatments.  
Please keep a record of this and bring it with you on or before first arrival.
- Dogs must be over 6 months old. They must be healthy, fit and show no signs of illness including but not limited to vomiting and diarrhoea. If you think your dog has a temperature or is off its food, please **DO NOT BRING TO CLASS**.
- We use veterinary approved disinfectant and take every precaution to reduce the risk of disease.
- All dogs must be chipped, and they must have up-to-date contact details.
- Dogs that are aggressive to other dogs or to people **CANNOT** attend group fun agility.  
Please contact me if you would like to discuss one-to-one or sole hire of the facility for your dog.
- Mutts & Butts reserves the right to ask an owner to leave if they believe the owner is behaving irresponsibly or the dog is aggressive.
- Your dog is your responsibility whilst participating in classes/hire/one-to-one sessions at our facility.  
We will take every precaution to keep you and your dog safe within our premises and on our equipment but take no responsibility for your dog for injury or loss.
- Do not bring any female in season. We will reschedule your classes to accommodate this.
- We will not accept negative or harsh dog handling or related equipment.  
Bring only a long standard lead plus a comfortable collar or harness plus treats and favourite toys.
- We may take video and use images of clients and dogs (in a good way) on social media. If you are **NOT** happy with this, please let us know. Otherwise, if you have agreed to allow us to film or use photos, we will do so. You have the right to ask us to remove any image if you wish.
- Mutts & Butts has public liability insurance suitable for fun dog agility training.  
Any physical activity can have risks and participation in our activities is entirely at the risk of the participant.  
We will not accept any responsibility for any injuries or losses sustained.  
Owners/handlers must ensure they have adequate pet insurance to cover for liability in the unlikely event of damage or injury caused by their dog to property, another dog or a third party.
